



SUPERCARS VOLUNTEER CARPARKING FAQS

10 – 12 JULY 2026

WHY??

The SuperCars carparking is the only fundraising event that the Townsville State High School (TSHS) P&C runs each year – and we make a lot of money from it! Nestled as we are in amongst the racetrack, TSHS is in the perfect location to provide this service for the Townsville community and generate much-needed funds for the school over only 3-days. The fundraising money will be used for school excursions, prizes, school equipment, shade structures and a new front entry for the school.

WHAT?

There are three different roles:

- **Volunteer Coordinator** (adult) - overseeing the operations, supporting the volunteers on shift and ensuring the smooth running of the event.
- **Gate Attendant** (adult) - taking payments for on-the-day sales and checking the pre-paid parking passes are valid on entry, using the EFTPOS machine to sell tickets or take in cash and give change, using the iPad to scan in pre purchased tickets.
- **Carparking Attendants** (adult and student) - directing vehicles to and around the oval and directing cars towards the next available parking spot, with a wave of a light saber. There will be painted lines on the oval to help keep cars neat and tidy. Point cars to spaces, try to make sure they can park front in. Reverse parking is discouraged during busy times when cars are queuing up.

NO parking of cars is necessary – volunteers are just there to direct the vehicles onto the oval and into the parking bays.

HOW?

It's easy to volunteer – simply click on the signup link below and pop your name down for a shift. Feel free to put your name down for multiple shifts – remember, each shift will get you one entry into our volunteer raffles (with **Adam Baillie, Member for Townsville, generously donating a Weber Baby Q BBQ** + there will be other prizes up for grabs). PLUS students will earn \$25 for each volunteer shift to be used towards their school fundraising event/senior formal.

WHAT DO I BRING?

- Wear fully enclosed shoes.
- Bring a sun safe hat and wear sun safe clothing, sunglasses are also good.
- Sunscreen and insect repellent will be provided.
- Food and drinks provided, but you might like to bring your own reusable water bottle.

WHAT DO I DO WHEN I GET THERE?

1. Refer to the site map below.
2. Park your own car in the school grounds (no charge of course!) Follow the yellow arrows to the First Street entrance of the school and once inside park where indicated, somewhere around the south-west corner of the hall.
3. Report to the Courtside Cafe, near the hall.
4. Sign in on the volunteer register and introduce yourself to the Volunteer Coordinator.
5. Grab a high viz vest + volunteer lanyard, both to be worn for the duration of your shift. If you're a car parking attendant, grab a parking wand aka light saber and check the batteries.
6. Each area will have a walkie-talkie - if you have been assigned one, check it is fully charged and do a quick comms check.
7. Sunscreen on, remember to always wear your hat and be sun safe.
8. Grab a drink out of the fridge, now's also the time for that final bathroom pitstop!
9. Head out towards the oval and receive a hand over from the outgoing volunteer.
10. Throughout your shift the Volunteer Coordinator will keep in touch with you - please notify them of any hazards or potential issues.

WHAT DO I DO WHEN MY SHIFT IS OVER?

1. Once your shift has finished head back to the Courtside Cafe, return any equipment such as your hi-viz vest, lanyard, and light saber and place radios on charge.
2. Sign off from the volunteer register.
3. Please refuel with any hot/cold food and drinks out of the fridge, with thanks to our Pitstop Crew aka our lovely canteen ladies.
4. Loved it! Feel free to sign up for another shift.
